Dr. Catherine Heaney

Dr. Heaney has been an associate professor at Stanford University in the Psychology and Human Biology department since 2005 and the School of Medicine since 2006. She received her Ph.D. in Health Behavior and Health Education from the University of Michigan School of Public Health.

Dr. Heaney's research focuses on examining how psychological factors, such as stress, social support, and organizational justice influence human health and disease. She has received numerous awards for her interdisciplinary research, including the Alice Hamilton Award for Excellence in Occupational Health and Safety in 2003.
